

The Proposed Development

BALLACH WIND FARM

- The Site lies approximately 4km northwest of Kilmorack, within the Erchless and Farley estates. The Site is primarily open ground. The Orrin Reservoir lies approximately 2km from the Site boundary and the A831 lies immediately to the south of the Site.
- The proposed layout presents a total of 36 turbines.
- The proposed turbines will be to a tip height of up to 230m. These heights are in line with current wind farm technology, economics, and similar applications throughout the country.
- The proposed development will also include access tracks, an on-site substation, borrow pits, a temporary construction compound and 5MW of battery storage.
- As part of our site design and assessment, we have prepared a Zone of Theoretical Visibility (ZTV) model, which assesses potential visibility out to 45km from the site centre and have prepared wirelines from key design viewpoints.
