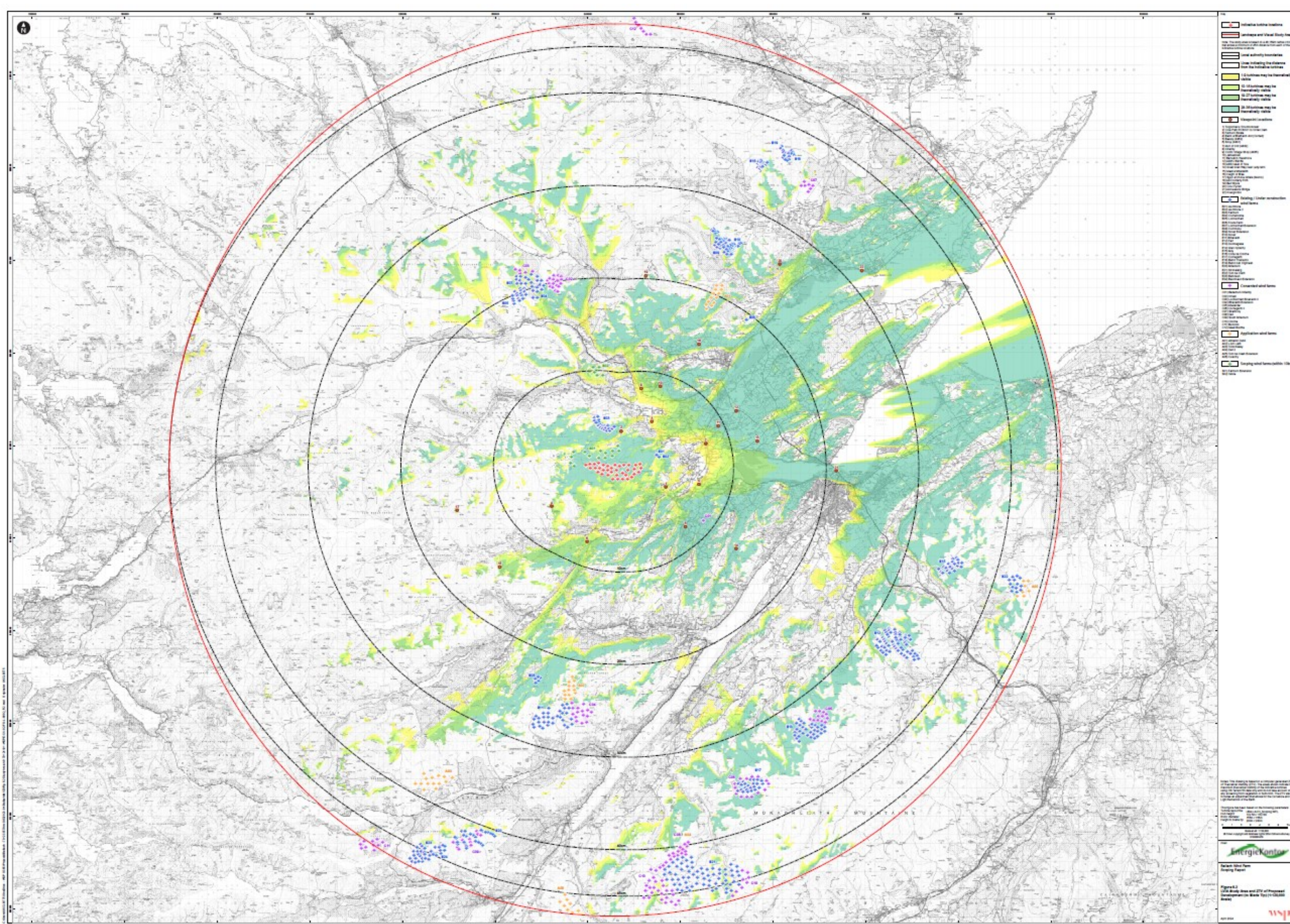


Zone of Theoretical Visibility — 45km

BLADE TIP HEIGHT WITH VIEWPOINTS: 45KM RADIUS

In terms of potential visual effects, the preliminary Zone of Theoretical Visibility, based on the 36 turbine layout and blade tip height of up to 230m, illustrates that theoretical visibility is fragmented due to undulating landform with the greatest visibility to the north-east and east at varying distances. Actual visibility would further limit views as a result of screening from intervening vegetation and / or built-form. There is very limited visibility from the most sensitive landscapes to the west, north-west and south-west.

The viewpoints selected represent the views of residents, road users, visitors, recreational users and tourists to the area through a combination of elevated summits, popular hill walking destinations as well as key transport routes used by residents and visitors in the area.



A series of wireframes from key design viewpoints has been provided as further visual aid to the proposed turbine layout. Once the full list of Viewpoints have been agreed, a full assessment with photomontages will be produced to accompany any application made.
