

>> Landscape and Visual — Method and Viewpoints

Landscape and visual impacts are a key consideration in any Energiekontor project.

As part of our landscape and visual assessment, we follow industry standard guidance produced by The Highland Council and NatureScot to present a robust assessment of the likely significant effects which may arise as part of the proposed development.

Each photomontage and wireline which will accompany the Landscape and Visual Impact Assessment (LVIA) is produced from view-points within the 45km LVIA Study Area and are selected to represent what the wind farm will look like in the wider area. These viewpoints are often close to residential areas, prominent hilltops and areas which are frequently used by receptors such as tourists, walkers and road users. A map showing the proposed viewpoints is provided below.

Since the last exhibition held in January 2023, a further viewpoint has been agreed with NatureScot with the total number of view-points standing at 21.
